

DIT Leadership Intern

UB Youth Camp Leadership Development Project 2020

What is it?

This position is for someone who has gone through DIT once and wants to take a next step in discipling and leadership. It is a one-week project during the DIT week. If you would like to serve as a camp staff volunteer for one or two weeks after that you are more than welcome to apply. The DIT Leadership Interns will take part in the program alongside the first year DITs, learning about discipling, doing inductive studies, etc. They will also take the next step by teaching the camp skills to the first year DITs, and lead in various ways like organizing the beach prayer evening, for example. The Leadership Interns are there to learn, to serve, to grow as disciplers by helping to disciple the first year DITs, to grow deeper with the Lord and to take advantage of every opportunity to lead. To be a Leadership Intern, you must be focused on Jesus, willing to serve others, and very aware of why you are there.

Where?

On site at Hidden Valley Camp in Paisley (our regular UB Youth camp location)

When?

Saturday, July 25 to Saturday August 1, 2020

Who is Leading it?

Directors Matthew and Sarah Steffler are experienced camp leaders, youth leaders and helped start DIT. They are also members of Stanley Park Community Church of the UB Conference. There will be 1-2 adult leaders working alongside.

What is the Cost?

\$425/person total cost to partially cover expenses of the DIT week including camp rental, supplies, food, hoodie, program & outreach costs. All staff are volunteers. The cost breaks down into:

\$100 application fee. Paid by applicant and is non-refundable if selected. We are limited in how many DIT leadership interns we can have.

\$325 remainder. This portion can be paid through support raising. It is not expected that participants will pay for the entire cost themselves, however, each participant is responsible for the entire amount, whether they choose to raise support or pay for it themselves. We will be assisting each participant to put together a support team for both prayer and finances. This is part of the faith growth! We also expect to do a fundraising event or two as a team. Remember how God supplied all your financial needs last summer for DIT!
